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InfAct outcomes

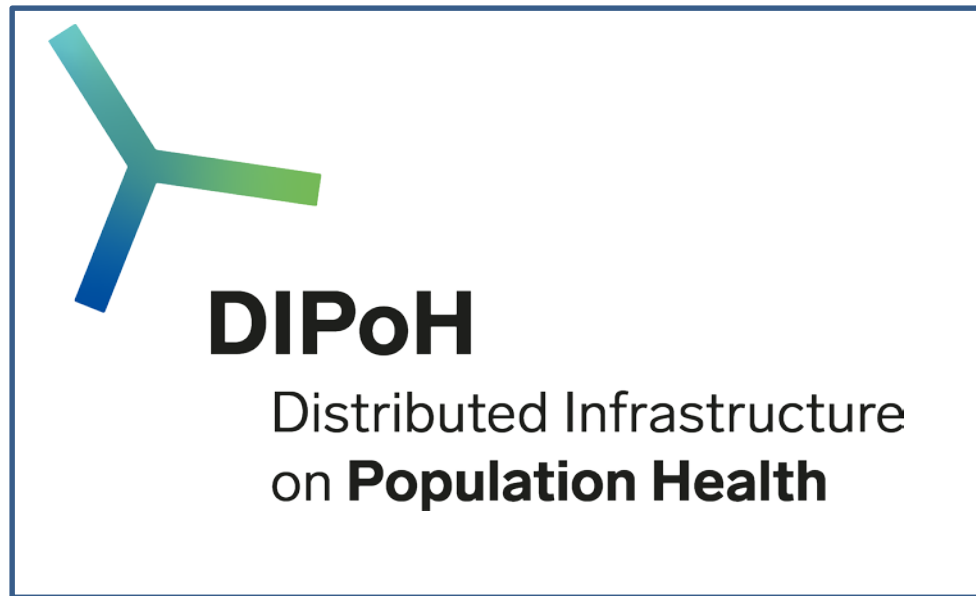
1. Reviewed existing data collection methods, metadata reporting standards and reuse of population health data

4. Developed a network of networks for DIPoH

5. Mapped interoperability enablers and barriers for data sharing and reuse
6. Investigated the use of data linkage of different data sources and the use of artificial intelligence (AI) in routine public health activities
7. Piloted distributed research infrastructure
