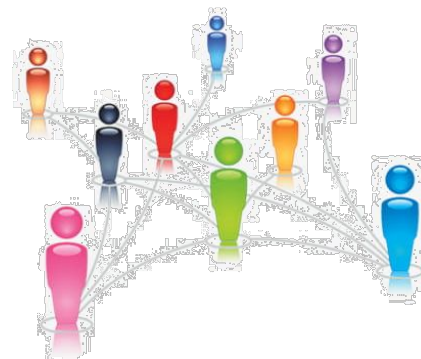
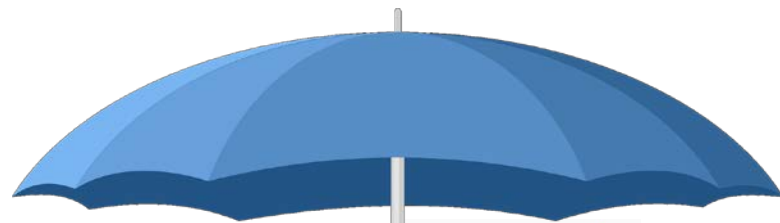

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Aims of Health Information Portal

- It is the website providing the support platform for health information in Europe.
- The main aim is to connect, to enable exchange of knowledge and of information, to promote cooperation within and between countries and research networks.
- Basis for Distributed Infrastructure on Population Health (DIPoH) website.

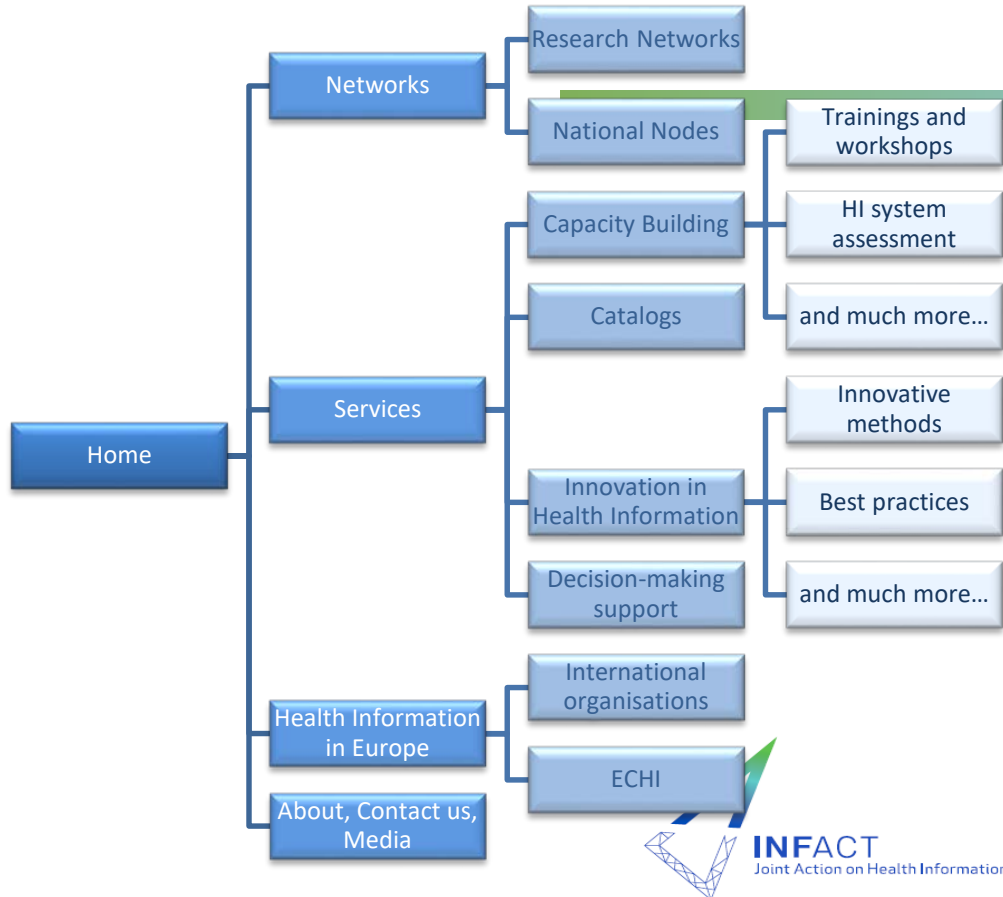


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One-stop-shop for health information



Structure of HIP



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Important features

- Connectivity
 - research networks and national nodes are connected
- Key words
 - Conceptual model is built in RNs and NNs to enable search functions.
- Searchable content
- Live HIP will encourage cooperation within and between countries and RNs.



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Meta-data on national nodes and research networks

- Metadata on national nodes and research networks were developed during Summer 2020.
- Tested on 5 NNs and 3 RNs to evaluate
 - the feasibility of requested data and
 - the burden for countries' representatives and RN coordinators.
- Besides, many information on health information in Europe landscape has been collected.



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National Nodes

- National node = A network of national stakeholders working with the health information and being owners/controllers of health and health care data
- Portal provides a catalogue of national nodes describing
 - Included institutions and experts
 - Health information sources
 - description of source, managing institutions, link, type of source, key words, etc.
 - Dissemination materials on health information
 - Different publications and portals, key words, links,...
 - Involvement in different national projects
 - Involvement in different international projects and networks



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Research Networks

- Existing health domain specific research networks (e.g. EHES, EuroPeristat, ECHO,...)
- Provides information on
 - Included institutions and relevant international organizations
 - Experts
 - Tools and publications
 - Results of the project
 - Repository of documents
 - Tools, data and information
 - Legislation (if relevant)
 - Guidelines
 - Dissemination materials (presentations, videos, infographics etc.)
 - Events and news
